Havana, June 24, 1715

On the said day, there entered in the said port the fleet under the command of General Ubilla, after 52 days of sailing from Vera Cruz. It was made up of Capitana, Almiranta, (ship of) Soto Sánchez and Urca de Lima. It found in it (the port) the ships of Cheves (Echevers); they were Capitana, Almiranta, Concepción, registro named San Miguel, and two prizes---one French and the other Dutch. And the referred-to (ships) plus a frigate which had come from the Canaries, which the said General of Flota bought, with a French ship called El Grifón; they left in convoy from the said port 24 July; and all of them made up the number of 12 vessels.

Bahama Channel, 30 July 1715

On the said day, the ships, finding themselves near Cape Canaveral, that a very strong/struck them; it lasted until the next (day) of St. Ignacio de Loyola, at 4:30 in the morning, when they found themselves lost in the order which is stated.
